Primary Responsibilities

The **Police Commander** is the management level class responsible for administration, supervision, activities, and operations within the department, and for providing leadership and professional assistance in developing and implementing the policies, procedures and plans of the department. This classification is distinguished from the next lower classification of Police Lieutenant by the performance of highly responsible and complex departmental management duties.

Qualifications

<u>Experience</u>: Seven (7) years of increasingly responsible law enforcement experience, including two years in a supervisory capacity comparable to that of a Police Sergeant with the City of Madera.

<u>Education</u>: Bachelor's Degree in criminology, police science or a related field. Completion of the P.O.S.T. Leadership Institute and 5 years supervisory experience may be substituted for the educational requirements.

<u>License/Certificates:</u> Valid CA Drivers License. Possession of P.O.S.T. Intermediate and Advanced Certificates. Possession of a P.O.S.T. Supervisory Certificate. Completion of the P.O.S.T. Sherman Block Leadership Institute is desirable.

Application Process

Applications must be received no later than **3pm on Friday, June 15, 2018**. Only those applicants who meet the qualification standards of this position on or before the posted final filing date will be allowed to participate in the examination process. Examination scores determine standing on eligibility lists. The examination process may consist of the following parts: <u>APPLICATION PACKAGE REVIEW</u> (Qualifying only): Only the most qualified applicants, based upon the information provided on the application will be invited to participate in the oral/performance examination processes. <u>ORAL EXAM</u> (100% weight value); Candidates must earn a score of 70% or higher in the examination process to be considered for the eligibility list. The City Administrator upon recommendation of the Department head will make the final selection and appointment.
