# **Business Matters**

- 1. Approval of Minutes Meeting of February 20, 2024. Vice Chairperson Mohammad moved to approve the minutes as presented; motion seconded by Councilmember Robbins. All council members voted yes to approve the minutes. Motion passed unanimously.
- 2. Discussion of City Transit System concerns for the disabled community (Chairperson Becker). Chairperson Becker brought forth specific concerns that Council Member Gladys Marroquin inquired about regarding maps showing the community where they can go to and from, including bus stop signs, time schedules and drivers. Chairperson Becker asked for updates on the progress of the routes and signage. Grant Administrator, Marcela Zuniga, informed the

advisory council of the implementation of a fourth route that began January 6, 2024, to the existing fixed route system. Chairperson Becker brought about another concern from residents guestioning why there are empty buses that don't seem to go where residents want to go. Grant Administrator Marcela Zuniga mentioned that a consultant was hired from WSP to look at the fixed route system and find a more streamlined system opposed to routes being zig zagged throughout the community. Route maps are available on the City of Madera website, under transit, and drivers also have schedules available. There has been a bit of trial and error concerning new bus stops and/or removal and the importance of hearing directly from the community regarding these concerns needing to be addressed. Program Manager - Grants Xochitl Villasenor showed route maps from the website and took note of the request to print larger, more legible versions and updated maps that will be posted within the buses and shelters. It was also noted that all fares are free of charge, aside from the Dial-A-Ride Service (DAR). These notifications are posted and are expected to be publicly available. Conversation occurred regarding the semicircular seats at specific bus stops in response to requests for "seating" readily available at bus stops. The concern was on the measurement of the seats and whether they were ADA compliant. Conversations surrounded the potential for a proposed turnout bus stop at the Walmart retail site. The City of Madera is in support of the concept and meetings are ongoing regarding a stop at the retailer's location. Marcela will follow up on providing multi-route maps, speak with the fleet manager regarding lifts on buses, and feedback on what is available to address concerns expressed.

- 3. Introduction of the Draft ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan (Wendy Silva) Wendy provided an overview of what an ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan is and advised the advisory council that the draft document is posted to <u>www.madera.gov/ADA</u>. The Public Outreach Meeting with the consultant that prepared the plan will occur at the next ADA Council meeting. Advisory council members were asked to encourage meeting participation from the public and to bring any feedback on priorities or findings to the next meeting for the consultant to consider before a final draft is issued.
- 4. Advisory Councilmember Reports-Council Member Ortegón suggested the Transit Advisory Board to report to the ADA Advisory Council after each of their meetings. Wendy advised that different boards and commissions have different responsibilities, and it would be more appropriate for interested Advisory Council Members to attend the transit meeting if they were interested. Someone who attends the meeting can provide the Advisory Council an update.

Meeting adjourned at 4:39 p.m.
