**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MADERA,
CALIFORNIA APPROVING THE CONTRACT AWARD FOR THE AVENUE 13
SEWER INTERCEPTOR REHABILITATION PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$8,328,452.00 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE
AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY**

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2024, the City of Madera (City) Engineering Department advertised a solicitation for construction bids for the Avenue 13 Sewer Interceptor Rehabilitation, City Project SS-00014, hereinafter referred to as “the Project”; and

WHEREAS, four sealed bids were received on May 29, 2024, and opened by the City Engineer; and

WHEREAS, SAK Construction, LLC, was selected as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Project is programmed in the Capital Improvement Projects Budget for Fiscal Year 2023/24 under CIP Projects Avenue 13 Sewer Interceptor Rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently operating under a local declaration of emergency due to the recent failures of the Avenue 13 sewer trunk main on June 3, 2024; and

WHEREAS, a failure in the Avenue 13 sewer trunk main occurred again on June 10, 2024 necessitating an additional emergency declaration.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MADERA HEREBY finds, orders and resolves as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein as if set forth in full.
2. The City Council (Council) has reviewed and considered all of the information presented including the report to Council from the Engineering Department.
3. The City Council finds that SAK Construction, LLC, is the lowest qualified responsible and responsive bidder, and does hereby accept the bid of SAK Construction, LLC.
4. The City Council awards the bid to SAK Construction, LLC, with the finding it is in the best interests of the City. The City Council approves an Agreement for the project, attached as Exhibit “A,” in the amount of \$8,328,452.00 with SAK Construction, LLC, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the same on behalf of the City. The City

Manager is further authorized to make any non-material, technical, and clerical edits and corrections to the Agreement, including performance and payment bonds completed after the award, subject to approval as to form by City Attorney.

5. Council authorizes construction contingencies of up to 20 percent as approved by the City Engineer.
6. This Resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
