APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion to approve minutes for November 18, 2024, meeting by Karla Gran, seconded by Joseph Hebert.

Motion was approved unanimously with one abstention.

A. CAPEX PROJECT

A-1 2025 Priority Improvement Plan

Joseph Hebert opened a discussion on prioritizing a project plan following the release of the USGA report. Dan Bacci confirmed that he has not received a quote for the central control system and reminded the committee about the previous meeting's discussion regarding satellite communications from Toro Communication. The quote focuses primarily on control and wireless communications, excluding piping or head replacement. The upgrade is significant due to the outdated technology currently in place, as there is no central system established. This upgrade would align with the USGA's recommendations.

Jose Rodriguez reiterated what was discussed in the prior meeting. Dan Bacci explained that under the current setup, there is no head control, which prevents precise management of water distribution in specific areas. As a result, bunkers are often overwatered or require manual watering, leading to inefficiency.

Ed McIntyre requested a comprehensive report detailing how items are categorized to better identify the golf course's needs.

In response, Dan Bacci stated that he would obtain a comprehensive report outlining water delivery, distribution acquisition, and quotes, and will follow up with the committee.
